
OLD DUNDAS AND OLD ANCASTER ROAD COMMUNITY MEETING



LAND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

We in Ward 12 and Ward 13 acknowledge that the City of Hamilton is situated upon the traditional territories of the Erie, Neutral, Huron-Wendat, Haudenosaunee and Mississaugas. This land is covered by the Dish With One Spoon Wampum Belt Covenant, which was an agreement between the Haudenosaunee and Anishinaabek to share and care for the resources around the Great Lakes. We further acknowledge that this land is covered by the Between the Lakes Purchase, 1792, between the Crown and the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation.

Today, the City of Hamilton is home to many Indigenous people from across Turtle Island (North America) and we, in the Ward 12 office, recognize that we must do more to learn about the rich history of this land so that we can better understand our roles as residents, neighbours, partners and caretakers.

OLD DUNDAS AND OLD ANCASTER ROADS




- Created at the end of 18th century by Richard Hatt so that farmers could reach his grist mill

- When originally built, it was designed to conform with the natural contours of the land.




